## Printing Bills: Approving bills and creating images for email or reprint

In previous versions of Timeslips, you had to print bills to a printer in order for Timeslips to be able to create a reprint image.

As you know, this image was needed to send bills by email or to reprint bills at a later time.

In Timeslips 2012, when you print bills to printer, text file, rich text format (RTF) file, or PDF file, you are able to send those bills by email and reprint those bills at a later time. Combined with the feature I reported on last week, you can now print bills to Display, then immediately print them to PDF or RTF and email the bills for a greater saving on time and paper.

What does this mean for you and your billing process? It means that Timeslips 2012 is helping you go green by giving you greater functionality with digital document output and no longer forces you to print hard copy bills to your printer in order to get a bill image!
