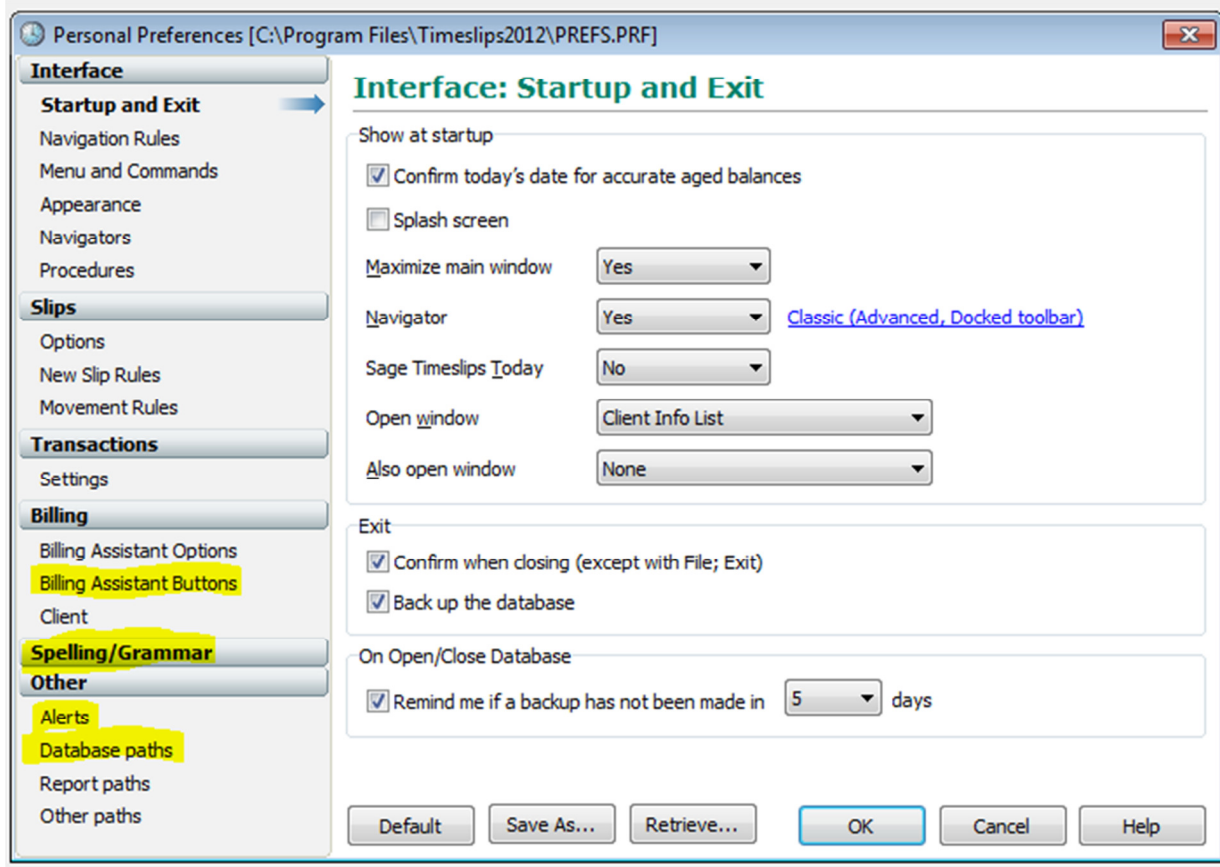


What's New and Improved in Timeslips 2012?

Settings: Personal Preferences User Interface has been enhanced

The Personal Preferences dialog box has been updated to provide easier access to groups of preferences. The navigation bar on the left presents data more clearly and allows users to easily change their personal preferences.



Some new preferences are now available:
